Galena Clinic was founded by Dr. Kenneth Davis who, after serving 25 years in treating substance abuse patients at public and private treatment centers, recognized a surge in white-collar and adolescent opiate addiction and sought to provide a clinic environment that would meet the specific lifestyle demands of professional and adolescent patients.

Galena Clinic's mission is supported by the employment of highly trained and licensed staff specializing in the treatment of opiate addictions and Methadone treatment.

Mission

Galena Clinic is a private, outpatient clinic specializing in a medical-model approach to opiate addictions treatment. Galena Clinic is committed to providing one-on-one medical attention and services that meet the specific needs of professional and diverse lifestyles. The clinic provides high-quality, medical care in a professional, confidential and safe environment.

Philosophy

The staff of Galena Clinic believes that opiate addiction is a disease of the brain, which will not change with the passage of time. Tools are provided for the development of behavior management skills for sober living and assist each person's right of self-determination according to his or her aspirations and capabilities.

Approach

Galena Clinic treats patients with a chronic dependency to medically prescribed and recreational forms of opiate derivatives, including heroin, Vicodin, Demerol, Percodan and Oxycontin, and other narcotics. In the course of treatment, we use the medication, Methadone and Buprenorphine. Along with supportive services, Methadone has been proven to be the most effective and widely used medical treatment for opiod addiction.



Methadone works in several ways:

- ✓ The correct Methadone dose does not make you feel "high" or "drugged" like other opiods do, so you can lead a normal life.
- ✓ Methadone's gradual, long lasting effects - 24 hours or more - takes away the hunger or craving for other opiod drugs.

- ✓ Scientific studies have proven that Methadone is just as safe as any other medicine prescribed by doctors. Methadone taken under our physician's care causes no harm to any of your body organs and does not change your ability to think clearly.

Treatment Regime

We believe in the concept of a blocking dose that will totally eliminate not only the feelings of withdrawal, but also the craving to use. It is the craving that causes the individual to engage in self-destructive behavior.

Four phases of treatment are offered:

Phase One: Intensive Stabilization

The patient is stabilized on an optimum dosage of Methadone. Acute medical problems are addressed and use of alcohol and other drugs is minimized.

Phase Two: Rehabilitation

The primary goal is to achieve balance and stability in the primary areas of functioning. The patient is on a comfortable dosage and begins forming a new identity based on a healthy, drug-free lifestyle.

Phase Three: Tapering

The purpose of this phase is to taper off Methadone without relapsing to drug use or other self-destructive behavior.

Phase Four: Transitional

The patient is reaching a "zero dose" of Methadone and begins to participate in aftercare. The primary goal is to reinforce relapse prevention and coping skills to maintain a balanced and stable lifestyle.
